

UA Mobile App Download instructions from the Device

The UA app is a FREE download for all supported devices

iPhone/iPod Touch or iPad

- Look for the App Store icon on your device, then tap it to open the App Store
- To browse the App Store, the device must be connected to the Internet or cellular service. To download apps, you also need an Apple ID which is typically required when setting up your device. By default, iPhone gets your Apple ID settings from iTunes.
- Tap Search at the bottom, then tap the search field and enter “University of Alabama”; select the app with the



following icon

- Tap “Free”, then tap “Buy Now”
- Sign in using your Apple ID, then tap OK
- If you don’t have an Apple ID, tap Create New Apple ID to set one up.
- If a download is interrupted, the device starts the download again the next time it has an Internet connection.
- Once you download an app, it’s immediately installed on the device.

Android Market

- Select the Android Market on your device
- Search for “University of Alabama”, select the app with the following icon
- The item details screen will appear and you can read more about the item
- To install the item, select the FREE button
- Press OK to accept the permissions for the app, the item will start downloading immediately



BlackBerry App World

- Navigate to the BlackBerry App World on the My World screen of your device
- On the Featured Items screen, press the Menu key.
- Click Search.
- Type “University of Alabama”, select the app with the following icon
- To download, on the Details screen, press the Menu key.
- Click Purchase.
- Click Buy Now.
- You can find and open your downloaded items on the My World screen. You can also find downloaded items on the Home screen of your device, or in one of the following folders on the Home screen of your device: Downloads or Applications.
